Hello Chief Bremner: Brian and I, and our entire family, would like to thank the fire crew that attended our recent grass fire here on the farm. Our heartfelt gratitude to the entire crew for promptly and efficiently extinguishing what could have been a catastrophic fire. We would also like to commend Capt. Dale Lundy for spotting the suspicious smoke when returning from the Trincomali structure fire and taking the initiative to bring in the trucks and crew to check it out. His decision made the difference in getting that fast-moving grass fire under control. We have not been able to determine what caused this fire which has made us very uneasy. The tractor and two trailers were in close proximity but the tractor wasn't overly hot or in tall, uncut grass. This extremely dry weather condition has made our hay fields tinder dry and we will proceed with our hay making with utmost caution. I hope we never experience another grass fire again as we were all shaken with this one, especially not knowing what caused it.
